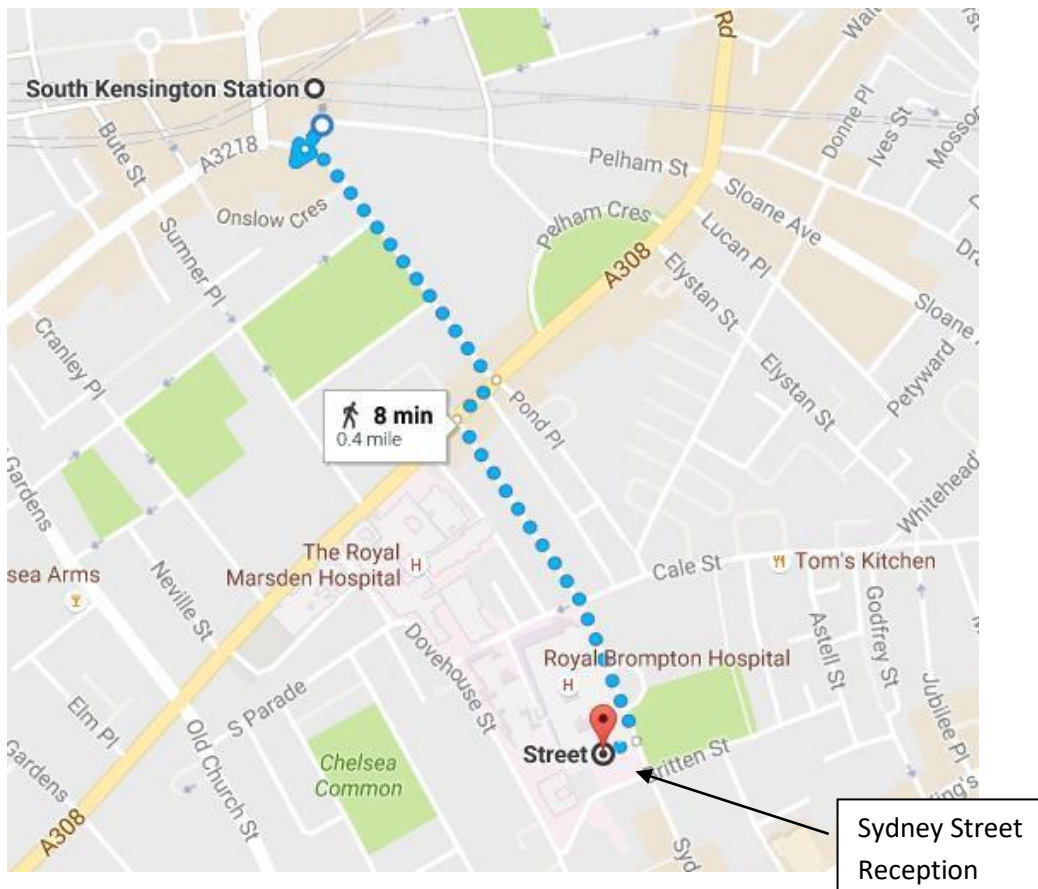

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### **Underground**

The nearest station is South Kensington (Piccadilly, District and Circle Lines)  
Royal Brompton Hospital is a ten to fifteen minute walk from South Kensington Station (see above map), veering left as you come out of the station along past Onslow Square and Sydney Place and then taking a right then left onto Sydney Street.

### **Buses**

The following buses serve the area:  
Numbers 14 and 345 along Fulham Road. (Sydney Wing/Outpatients Department)  
Numbers 11, 19, 22, 49, 211 and 319 on Kings Road. (Sydney Wing/ Chelsea Wing)

### **Parking**

There is very limited parking, operated as a Pay and Display, available on site.  
Very little street parking is available in the neighbouring streets.  
Royal Brompton has four parking spaces for disabled car drivers in Cale Street, three in Foulis Terrace and two in the Sydney Wing car park.

### **When you arrive**

Upon arrival at the Main Reception in Sydney Wing, simply follow the signposts to the right, past the café to seminar rooms 1 & 2 for the myocarditis patient and relative information evening.
