



As a parent of a child with pediatric cardiomyopathy you know first-hand that PCM is rare and often devastating heart condition. Tenaya Therapeutics, a biotechnology company committed to discovering, developing, and delivering curative therapies that address the underlying causes of heart disease is sponsoring a study around this condition.

MyClimb is a Natural History Study designed to collect and evaluate information on the course of cardiomyopathy in children and adolescents with the *MYBPC3* genetic mutation.

A thorough understanding of the natural history of a disease is the foundation of the development of new therapies. The **MyClimb** study has been carefully designed to collect data that will provide researchers more information about the *MYBPC3* genetic mutation.

The **MyClimb** study is both retrospective (looking back at your child's medical chart) and prospective (collected during your regularly scheduled visits).

Tenaya empathizes with the challenges families face living with chronic conditions and have designed the **MyClimb** study to be simple and secure for children, parents, and families.

- This study will be 5 years in duration, starting from enrollment for many participants, for others it involves simply granting permission for the study to gather data from your medical chart
- Assessments will be completed as part of a participant's regular schedule of physician visits, no additional visits will be required;
- Aside from a simple annual blood draw, assessments are non-invasive;
- You or your child will be asked to fill out Quality of Life questionnaires at each visit;
- Individual names or identifying information will not be shared as part of the study;
- Data relating to demographic, genetic, environmental, and other variables that correlate with the disease and its outcomes will be collected.

The prospective portion of the study will last for 5 years and compensation may be available for travel expenses as well as study related blood draws.
